Demolition's a snap

A demolition excavator, which can cut a 24-inch reinforced concrete column in one bite, continued ripping apart a 485,000-square-foot building near the Domain in North Austin this week. The demolition of the former 1970s-era IBM office building and manufacturing facility started two weeks ago, and the site is expected to be cleared and re-landscaped by early 2008. The building sits on part of the 176 acres where Austin-based Endeavor Real Estate Group LLC plans to build its massive Domain mixed-use project.
